

KILLARNEY PARK RESERVATION INFORMATION 2003

RECENT CHANGES: You cannot change or cancel your park reservation until 4 months prior to your start date. This was done to prevent people rolling reservations forward until they hit the dates they wanted.

Ontario Parks now has a centralized reservation service for all parks. Reservations for Killarney Provincial Park can be made by:

- Telephone: 1-888-ONT-PARK (1-888-668-7275)
- Internet: <http://www.ontarioparks.com> (However, ONLY to reserve George Lake campground sites; NOT backcountry/interior sites)

Park reservations can be made **up to 5 months in advance.**

(so you can make reservations for **July 1st 2003 starting on February 1st, 2003**)

Reservations can be made by phone from 7am to 11pm EST, seven days a week, and if you wish to reserve George Lake campground sites you can use the internet 24 hours a day. .

IMPORTANT CHANGE AT THE BELL LAKE ACCESS: The park is now only issuing permits at the Bell Lake Access for the months of July and August. They will be open from the last Friday in June until Labour Day Monday, from 8:30am to 5pm.

KILLARNEY PARK FEES

Fee Summary - Interior Camping:

Non-refundable reservation fee: \$9.00

- under 6: free
- 6-17 years old: \$3.25/night
- 18-64 years old: \$8.00/night
- 65+ years old: \$6.25/night

Changes and cancellation fee: \$6.00

Reservations mailed or faxed to the park will be returned.

Chikanishing Creek Parking:

\$ 9.00 per day per vehicle

Crownland Camping for non-Canadian citizens:

\$10 per night per person (18 yrs and older)

(Required if camping on Philip Edward Island)

Interior Camping:

\$8 per night per person

George Lake Main Campground Camping:

Spring/fall: \$18.75 per night per campsite

Summer: \$24 per night per campsite

Day Pass:

\$9.00 per vehicle
